Each week features fun activities with a focus on outdoor activity, creativity & exploration.

SESSION ONE: June 28th – July 2nd
Theme: “Express Yourself”

This week we will learn about art and how to express ourselves creatively. We will be doing various creative activities such as clay sculpting and canvas painting. We will be having an art student coming into the program to teach us some fun art techniques. Please note camp is closed on July 1st for the Canada Day holiday.

SESSION TWO: July 5th – 9th
Theme: “Young Scientists”

This week, the children will become scientists and learn about different chemical reactions. They will be doing lots of science experiments throughout the week. We will be taking a trip to the Museum of Science and Technology.

SESSION THREE: July 12th – 16th
Theme: “Kitchen Creations”

This week the children will become creative chefs. We will be learning different recipes and creating some new ones. We will be going to a local grocery store to have a cooking class and then we will be putting our skills to the test by making some food for our bake sale at the end of the week.

SESSION FOUR: July 19th – 23rd
Theme: “Fun in the Sun”

This week is all about enjoying the summer weather. We will be spending the week doing various outdoor activities. We will be having a picnic lunch and spending a day at the beach swimming and building sand castles. We will also be discussing water safety.

SESSION FIVE: July 26th – 30th
Theme: “Animal Kingdom”

This week we will be exploring the animal world. We will be talking about different animals around the world and how they live. We will also be learning about endangered species and what we can do to help. This week we will be taking a trip to Papanack Zoo.

SESSION SIX: August 2nd – 6th
Theme: “He Shoots, He Scores!”

This week is all about sports! Each day we will be learning about a different sport, the rules of the game, what type of equipment is used and of course playing the game! We will also be focusing on other aspects of sports such as being a team player, leadership and fair play. For our field trip we will be going skating on a local rink. Please note camp is closed on August 2nd for the Civic Holiday.

SESSION SEVEN: August 9th – 13th
Theme: "Fantasy Island"

Fantasy rules this week. We will be exploring the world of fantasy and all the mythical creatures involved in it. We will spend the week creating fantasy stories of our own and act them out as plays at the end of the week. Our trip this week will be to Odyssey Theatre to see a play.

The Family Centre camp is for children aged 6 – 10 years old.

The cost is \$140.00 per week, beginning June 28th and continuing until Sept 3rd, 2010.

SESSION EIGHT: August 16th – 20th
Theme: "Our Natural World"

SESSION NINE: August 23rd – 27th
Theme: "Splish Splash"

Come prepared to get wet! This week involves water fun and lots of it! We will be doing many activities such as water relays, water balloon toss, and so much more. Our field trip this week will be to Water Amusement Park.

SESSION TEN: August 30th – Sept 3rd
Theme: "The Last Hurrah!"

Since this is the last week of summer vacation we figured we would go out with a bang! This week will be a week of crazy fun. Each day will be a different theme such as crazy hair day, Pj day, and movie day. For our field trip we will be visiting a movie theatre to watch one of the new releases this summer.
