The outdoor space was designed around nature. The lush green yard complete with hills, gardens and pond is an outdoor environment that enhances learning opportunities. Discovery and exploration are encouraged as the children learn to respect the natural world.



The program is rich with sensory learning experiences to support the unique learning styles. The sandbox is a core piece of classroom equipment – the materials are changed based on the children’s interests. Emergent curriculum stems from the interests of children and relies on teacher’s knowledge of child development to plan for the program.



The program spaces are planned out thoughtfully, inviting the toddlers to engage in a wide variety of fun, interesting, challenging and developmentally appropriate activities – the primary pencils with paper and clipboards is an example of an emergent literacy opportunity.



Spontaneity plays a large role in the children’s play and learning, the educator follows the children’s lead joining a group of children in their activity.
